


Land Acknowledgement





The village also houses an extensive archival collection comprised of records created by the Councils of the former Townships of Georgina and North Gwillimbury, as well as the Village of Sutton. In addition, the archives contain a number of personal family documents, including land records, photographs, scrapbooks, bibles and related collectibles or memorabilia. The village also hosts a number of popular special events and programs throughout the year.

Georgina Military Museum 26061 Woodbine Ave., Keswick 905-989-9900

The Georgina Military Museum brings history to life with a collection of military vehicles and artillery pieces. You'll find presentations and artifacts from the earliest days of Upper Canada conflict to current peacekeeping efforts.

Open Saturdays and Sundays, the museum offers an opportunity to view what so many had to endure, experience and overcome, and also serves as a reminder of the inherent tragedy of war and the necessity of making every effort to prevent armed conflict.

Eildon Hall Museum 26071 Park Rd., Jackson's Point 905-722-8061 georgina.ca

Located on the grounds of Sibbald Point Provincial Park, Eildon Hall Museum - one of the oldest structures in the area - was the residence of pioneer Susan Mein Sibbald (1783-1866).

The home was expanded and transformed into an extensive rural manor. The estate remained in the Sibbald family until 1952. Eildon Hall Museum displays 19th century artifacts and furniture.



SIGHTSEEING

Historic Briars Resort

Located at 55 Hedge Rd., the Briars is the site of a number of historic buildings, with the most notable being the octagonalshaped Peacock House, the only one in Ontario. The manor house is comprised of a central rubblestone structure built in 1840 and two flanking wings clad in brick added in 1880. Despite the setbacks of the wings, the building appears as a unified structure, and its central portion is regarded as a fine example of Regency architecture.

Jackson's Point Harbour Lighthouse

The lighthouse celebrates the spirit of Jackson's Point and the harbour as a destination on Lake Simcoe. You can take in great views of it at Bonnie Park, 1 Bonnie Blvd., Jackson's Point or at the Ramada Resort.

St. George's Anglican Church

St. George's Church and Cemetery, located at 408 Hedge Rd. in Jackson's Point, is a beautiful heritage site adjacent to Sibbald Point Provincial Park. In the 1877 stone church, you will discover the stained glass window designed by Mrs. Simcoe, the wife of Ontario's

first Lt. Governor. It is also the final resting place of Canadian writers Stephen Leacock and

Mazo de la Roche.





WALKING TOUR



Downtown Sutton

What began as a small village of around 100 residents has grown into a vibrant and welcoming community. In its early days, Sutton was home to a tannery, tavern, school, post office, blacksmith, shoemaker, cloth factory and wool mill. Today, this charming downtown has evolved into a hub of unique shops, cozy cafés, inviting restaurants and local businesses that serve both the growing population and visitors from nearby Toronto—just an hour's drive away.

One of Sutton's most iconic landmarks is the former Mansion House Hotel, one of the oldest buildings on the main street. From the mid-1800s to the mid-1900s, it hosted travelers from near and far—rooms were once just \$1 a night.

Jackson's Point

Before it became a beloved getaway destination, Jackson's Point was a peaceful lakeside farming community. By the late 1800s, grand estate homes transformed into hotels, and quaint cottages were repurposed into dance halls and restaurants. Visitors arrived by boat, train, and trolley to enjoy summers by the lake—often for just \$40 a season, or \$1 for a night's stay. Families came for the swimming, boating, fishing, golfing and the timeless charm of lakeside living.

Step Into History

The Sutton and Jackson's Point area is steeped in rich history. <u>Download a walking tour map.</u> As you explore local shops and eateries, you'll likely be greeted with the warm, communal spirit of Georgina's residents—many of whom are happy to share stories that bring the past to life.



Escape the hustle and bustle of the every day and unwind during the warmer months outdoors in Georgina's year-round recreational playground. The Town has many activities and experiences to help you plan a well-rounded adventure close to the city.

Trails, rock climbing, golf, paintball – we have it all. There are even dog parks for your fur-friends to get active, too. So, get outside and enjoy the beauty of the season. Pack your sunscreen and start planning your day trip or overnight getaway today.



Explore a range of trail experiences and discover an abundance of natural spaces on land and near water. The Town's trail systems include more than 117 kilometres of multi-use trails. Stop to refuel in one of our downtowns at a cafe or restaurant or cool off at a waterfront park. Learn more about Georgina's trails and access points.



Need a place for your fur-friend to stretch their legs and let out some energy? Georgina has two leash-free dog parks. One is located at 685 Lake Dr. S., and the other is in front of the Georgina Animal Shelter and Adoption Centre at 26815 Civic Centre Rd. Learn more at georgina.ca/DogParks. If you are planning to bring your dog to an event, please check ahead of time to ensure it is pet-friendly.



Renowned courses, driving ranges and miniature golf - there is a golf experience in Georgina for all ages and skill levels. Courses throughout the Town offer nine-hole and 18-hole play, as well as cart rentals. If you choose a course close to Lake Simcoe, be sure to snap a picture of its stunning sunsets, which provide a picturesque backdrop on a groomed course. See a list of golf experiences.



With eight fields spanning 25 acres, Georgina Paintball in Pefferlaw is one of the largest and most popular paintball locations for a heart-thumping adventure in the GTA. Players over 10 years of age can bring their own equipment or rent it on site from the pro shop. Rain or shine, if you're in for some thrill-seeking adventure, you'll want to give paintball a try. Sharpen your short-tennis, pickleball and basketball skills at 38 Pete's Lane in Pefferlaw at the Pefferlaw Sports Zone. The Pefferlaw Park consists of a pump track and skatepark, which is designed for bikes, skateboards, rollerblades, scooters and other wheeled sports equipment, making it a hub for active fun. Picnic in the park or grab a bite to eat on Pefferlaw's main street for a great day of fun.



The ROC in Keswick offers a variety of recreation activities, such as high and low ropes challenge courses, rock climbing, vertical playground, zipline, walking and mountain bike park, playground, splash pad, bike course, soccer fields, baseball diamonds, basketball, beach volleyball, as well as pickleball and tennis courts. Boating/jet-skiing

In the heat of the summer, Georgina's waterfront is busy with watersport activity. Many rental options, lakeside resorts and 11 marinas along Lake Simcoe's shoreline make Georgina a water playground. Go for a cruise, splash some waves, anchor in between the islands and mainland for a shallow, sandy swim, or cast your line out to catch some big fish. Let's go boating! See a list of marinas and places to launch.

Paddling

Canoeing, kayaking and paddleboarding adventures are great ways to connect with nature and get away from it all. Georgina has three navigable rivers that connect to Lake Simcoe, where you can do just that - escape. Learn about popular routes, access points and places to stop.

Fishing

If you are looking for a new fishing spot or want to plan a fun outdoor activity with your family, a fishing getaway on Lake Simcoe in Georgina is only a short drive from the city. Thousands of visitors a year come to cast their lines into the waters of the largest inland lake in Ontario for their chance to catch the "Big One." See fishing and tackle stores.

Kiteboarding

Bright-coloured kites can often be seen swirling along the southern shore of Lake Simcoe on a windy day. kite.ca and ukite.ca offer lessons to all skill levels. They even supply the gear. This thrilling, out-of-the-norm activity may just be what the doctor ordered for thrill seekers who want an adrenaline-filled activity this season.

Swimming at waterfront parks

There are many public places throughout Georgina to refresh from the summer heat. Plan your day and visit one of the Town's seven waterfront parks or Sibbald Point Provincial Park in Jackson's Point. You can also make a splash at three waterfront resorts.



Georgina's close proximity to Toronto means boating enthusiasts can spend less time getting to the lake and more time on the water, enjoying Ontario's fourth-largest lake on the Trent-Severn Waterway. From the southern shores of Keswick to its northern harbours in Pefferlaw, Georgina is home to several premier marinas offering quality services and amenities.

Tour the open water and view the shores of Georgina Island, Sibbald Point Provincial Park and the Duclos Point Nature Reserve. Cruise the shallow waters off Snake Island around Island Grove or head for deeper depths around Fox Island. Stop at Jackson's Point Harbour for walkable shopping and dining options in historic downtowns. To see a list of shops and restaurants in Jackson's Point and Sutton, visit georgina.ca/downtowns.

Paddling along Georgina's southern Lake Simcoe shoreline or three navigable rivers is a desired destination for nature lovers. A short drive from the city, there are many access points, places to stop, scenic views and lots of wildlife.

Whether your adventure includes fishing, swimming or enjoying scenic views and wildlife, there is a route in Georgina for all skill levels. Don't own your own canoe, kayak or paddleboard? A stay at the Briars Resort in Jackson's Point gives you access.

Maskinonge River

With several marinas located at the mouth of the river, there's always lots of activity on the Maskinonge River in Keswick. Head inland and experience moderately shallow waters with twists and turns, lots of vegetation and plenty of birds. You'll see homes and marinas and cross under two bridges. Stop for a bite to eat at waterfront dining locations, such as **Boston** Pizza or the Riveredge Restaurant. From Lake Simcoe to the end of the river near Woodbine Avenue is just under three kilometres





Black River

The Black River offers tranquil nature views and rest stops. Many choose to start or end their trip in downtown Sutton at the dam, where they can browse local shops within walking distance, enjoy a meal or hydrate with a cold drink. Launch at Mill Pond Park or at the Sutton Parkette parking lot on High Street.

It is approximately 3.5 kilometres travelling north from the dam at High Street to Lake Simcoe. You'll pass under bridges, a golf course and private homes. Paddlers can also travel south from the top of the dam in Sutton to Baldwin. This scenic route will take you through many twists and turns, through the Devil's Elbow just before reaching the Baldwin Dam.

If you choose to start your trip on the shore at Bonnie Park or Malone Wharf in Jackson's Point, you can paddle along the shore to where the river meets at the Mossington Bridge and travel south on the Black River to Sutton.



Pefferlaw River

If nature and wildlife are in your itinerary, then the Pefferlaw River is your destination. Have lunch on <u>Pefferlaw</u>'s main street before you launch and wind your way towards Lake Simcoe. You can also start in Udora and follow the shallow waters north to the Pefferlaw Dam.







FISHING

Lake Simcoe is home to a variety of fish species and is the fourth-largest lake located entirely within Ontario, with 240 kilometres of shoreline situated between the communities of York Region, Durham Region, Simcoe County, Barrie, Orillia and Kawartha Lakes. The Town of Georgina covers 52 kilometres of shoreline and is located at the southern tip of the lake.

Year round, you'll sink your hook into lots of trophy-size fish such as bass, pike, walleye and lake trout. Whether you want to fish by boat or on land, you have many options in Georgina. You can cast your line at one of the local fishing sites on the shorelines of the lake or one of the rivers. If you prefer to make a day of it out on the water, local marinas and some parks have boat launches available.

For those who are looking to try recreational fishing for the first time, you can fish for free on the Mother's Day or Father's Day weekends when a licence is not required. One-day licences can also be purchased online or in person at Canadian Tire in Keswick or the Mobil Service Station in Sutton for \$12.21 (2025 rate).

Make sure to check Ontario's fishing regulations before you head out or plan your trip.

WHERE TO FISH

There are many popular fishing locations throughout Georgina. Cook's Bay, on the southern tip of Lake Simcoe in Keswick, provides a mix of weedy, shallow and deep water habitat – great for fishing! You'll find trophy-sized fish in the deeper waters like lake trout and whitefish, and many different species around the islands. Don't forget the rivers.

Please be respectful and aware that fishing within 300 metres of the Chippewas of Georgina Island First Nations properties is prohibited.


