WHY WE EMBRACE CONSERVATION DIFFERENTLY

In 1969, my father Gerry Ward visited Africa for the first time. He had never left the U.S., but my mother Diana worked as a flight attendant— with flight perks. Once routes to Kenya opened, Gerry jumped at the chance to go. And there, he fell in love with both the land and wildlife that made it home. Most of all, he was taken by the gentle might of the endangered African elephant.

When I was younger, he regaled my brothers and I with stories about the 5-ton elephants that stepped so softly that you could barely hear them. The trip had given Gerry more than just an appreciation for Africa's wild, he now felt a deep sense of urgency to help conserve it. So in 1974, my parents founded Wildlife Artists with a simple belief — realistic wildlife products will endear people to the natural world and inspire them to help protect it.

In the '70s, most wildlife products were fantastical. Gerry and Diana created products that looked like the magnificent beasts they saw in the wild. And as our differentiating beliefs grew our family business from its humble roots into an industry leader, we grew with it. As kids, we pierced jewelry together and took inventory on index cards, and today, we're proud to be leading our parents' legacy forward. Conservation and a love of the natural world remain at the core of every decision that we make.

And just as our father's conservation was grounded by his first trip, the Ward family continues to ground our company by fighting for conservation in-the-wild. We travel to Africa, Central America and the Asian rainforests to develop partnerships with local artisans and conservation groups. There, we've freed wild dogs from snare trips, delivered yarn and needles to remote villages, and much more, all to support those working tirelessly to preserve the natural world.

To put it simply, we walk the walk. For us, conservation is more than just eco-friendly, plastic-free products and sustainable in-office practices... it's who we are. And moving forward, we will never forget the lesson that our father and the African elephant taught us: just because we're growing, it doesn't mean our footprint has to get larger. To affect the most positive change for the wild, we must continue to think bigger and tread lightly.

CHOOSING THE PLANET OVER PLASTICS

In only six decades, the mass production of plastic has created more than 7 billion tons of waste. Alarmingly, only 9% of that plastic waste has been recycled.

That means that more than 5 billion tons of bags, bottles and other single-use plastics have rapidly accumulated in landfills that just can't handle the sheer amount of waste. So, much of this plastic ends up flowing into the ocean where it suffocates, starves and drowns marine life. Scientists predict that by 2050, our seas could contain more plastic waste than fish.

Eliminating plastic is absolutely critical to conservation and we're doing it everywhere we can.

We're on a mission to transform our industry and this is how we've gotten started:

In 2013, we first eliminated plastic whiskers from all of our plush.

In 2014, we eliminated plastic beans because these microplastics end up in waterways and oceans, killing hundreds of thousands of marine organisms every year. We are still the only company to eliminate these unnecessary microplastics.

In 2018, we transitioned all our plush to sustainable fill made only from recycled PET bottles, the first company to do so.

And, another industry first, **in 2019**, we eliminated all inner plastic bags & microplastics (including plastic taggers) because there's nothing eco about them. These single-use plastics, even the biodegradable ones, don't degrade once they are buried in a landfill or floating in the ocean and still pose a grave threat to the environment.

We're proud that other companies are following our lead, but our mission won't be complete until plastic waste no longer pollutes our lands and clogs our waterways. To protect the wild, we all must choose the planet over plastics.


HERE, FEW ARE EMPLOYED, AND THERE ARE EVEN FEWER OPPORTUNITIES FOR WOMEN.

THAT DAY WE'D COME BEARING YARN AND NEEDLES SO THAT THESE WOMEN COULD KNIT AND CROCHET PIECES FOR ONE OF OUR MOST UNIQUE COLLECTIONS. AFTER THEY FINISH, THEIR COMPLETED PIECES GO TO ANOTHER GROUP OF WOMEN WHO ASSEMBLE OUR HAND CRAFTED PIECES IN A WORKSHOP.

THESE WOMEN WALK AS FAR AS AN HOUR AND A HALF EACH WAY FOR THE INCOME AND ARE SUPPORTED WITH LIFE SKILLS TRAINING, INCLUDING HOW TO MANAGE MONEY, BUDGET AND OPEN BANK ACCOUNTS. ENGAGING AND EMPOWERING WOMEN IN LOCAL COMMUNITIES IS A CAUSE NEAR AND DEAR TO ME, MY FAMILY AND THE ENTIRE WILDLIFE ARTISTS' TEAM.

ANTI-POACHING INITIATIVE

TO SAVE A WILD DOG: A JOURNEY INTO THE AFRICAN BRUSH

TWO SUMMERS AGO, I HAD THE AMAZING OPPORTUNITY TO HELP PAINTED DOG CONSERVATION (PDC) RADIO COLLAR TWO PAINTED DOGS IN THE BUSH OF HWANGE, ZIMBABWE. THE AFRICAN PAINTED DOG IS ONE OF THE CONTINENT'S MOST ENDANGERED SPECIES AND PDC IS COMMITTED TO PROTECTING THEM WITH EDUCATION AND BOOTS-ON-THE-GROUND FIELDWORK.

THE DOGS WERE DENNING CLOSE TO A LOCAL COMMUNITY AND NEEDED TO BE TRACKED FOR THEIR SAFETY. USING MODIFIED TRAPS, FITTED WITH STOPPERS TO PREVENT HARM, OUR TEAM CAPTURED TWO ADULTS AS THEY RETURNED TO THEIR PUPPIES FROM A HUNT.WE ADMINISTERED A FAST-ACTING SEDATIVE AND HAD A BRIEF WINDOW TO PROVIDE MEDICAL ATTENTION AND COLLARING. ONCE THE DOGS AWOKE, THEY DASHED BACK INTO THE WILD, NOW PROTECTED FROM POTENTIAL POACHERS.

PDC CONFIRMED THAT OUR ACTIONS THAT DAY HAD RIPPLE EFFECTS FAR BEYOND THOSE TWO DOGS. PDC ESTIMATES THAT THE LIVES OF 137 DOGS CAN BE TRACED TO ACTIONS THAT SAVE JUST ONE.

THE STAKES FOR OUR PLANET AND ITS WILDLIFE HAVE NEVER BEEN HIGHER. THAT DAY WAS A HUMBLING REMINDER THAT PRESERVING NATURE'S BEAUTY REQUIRES MORE THAN JUST FCO-FRIENDLY PRODUCTS AND GOAL SETTING. THE EXPERTENCE WILL FOREVER STICK WITH ME



Mulberry Mongoose partners with anti-snare organizations, turning confiscated snare wire into coiled and hammered "beads" and mixing these beads with locally purchased semiprecious stones, freshwater pearls and hand carved wooden beads to create handcrafted, stunning one-of-a kind pieces of jewelry. Every piece of jewelry sold not only supports the livelihood of locals, lessening the need for people to turn to poaching in desperation for money, but also with each piece, Mulberry Mongoose makes a donation to anti-snaring patrols to support their work of wildlife protection and save animals that have been caught in snare wires, raising over \$119,000 to date.




